Project Description

Overview

The purpose of this project is to deploy firewalls with integrated wireless network coverage to eight remote locations, improving connectivity and security while providing a site to site connection to the resources available at the main AASC location.

Current Environment

AASC - Main Location – Cedar Bluff, VA

Professional Services

Professional services must be quoted to complete all work listed below and include travel and lodging (if needed). If quotes include blocks of service hours in lieu of a completed project approach, additional hours must be available to be used for any vendor-supported service over a twelve-month period. Quotes must specifically state how additional support hours may be consumed.

The eight FortiWifi 30E units are being purchased under a separate RFQ. Units can be shipped directly to vendor selected for this service RFQ. Return shipping charges from vendor to main AASC office in Cedar Bluff, VA must be included in quote if vendor prefers units be shipped to their location for configuration.

AASC staff is available to drop off and pick up units within a 2 hour driving distance radius of the main AASC office in Cedar Bluff, VA. If such arrangements include travel for a vendor representative, all associated costs must be included in quote.

AASC Provided:

- Account for access to current AASC and Haysi Fortinet appliances
- IP configuration for the seven existing sites
- TBD – IP configuration for Falls Mills
- Desired WiFi Password for each site
- Email address for FortiCare/FortiGuard registration

Work to be performed includes:

- Update current AASC and Haysi Firewalls to current stable/release software available at time of project award
- Configure eight new FortiWifi firewalls including:
 - Update to current stable/release software available at time of project award
 - WAN/LAN Interfaces
 - IPv4 Policy
 - Addresses/Objects, Services, Traffic Shapers as needed
 - Security Profiles per Fortinet “best practice” guidelines
 - IPSec Site to Site Tunnel to AASC
 - Wifi & Switch Controller
 - Should the Falls Mills IP configuration not be available prior to completed deployment and testing at the seven other sites, the FortiWifi unit should be configured as above

with an IP address from another site and documentation provided showing how to update for successful deployment once the IP details are available.

Project Completion

Sign off of project completion to be provided when the following criteria are met:

- All eight FortiWifi units have been tested for:
 - LAN connectivity
 - WiFi connectivity
 - Site to Site VPN connectivity
- Admin access credentials provided and tested by AASC IT staff
- 3 year FortiCare and FortiGuard contracts are reflected on all device UIs linked to AASC email address
